















## NEW: Online learning - Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND)

The focus will be on helping you understand what SEND support is as well as the benefits for a child or young person.

By using relevant case studies, you will be introduced to the Graduated Response and how each part of the cycle contributes to the aim of making progress and securing good outcomes. You will also learn more about person-centred planning and how it is used in practice.
