The focus will be on helping you understand what **SEND** support is as well as the benefits for a child or young person.

By using relevant **case studies**, you will be introduced to the **Graduated Response** and how each part of the cycle contributes to the aim of making progress and securing **good outcomes**. You will also learn more about **person-centred planning** and how it is used in practice.
