# 2023 SEND Services Survey Results Summary

### Introduction

The Parents and Carers Alliance MK (PACA MK) is an independent forum for parent carers of children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) who live in Milton Keynes. We share our experiences with decision makers to bring about real change to develop local services and to make lives better for our families.

In 2022 we launched our first annual SEND Services Survey which asked parents about their experiences of Education, Health and Social Care, as well as other support services for children with SEND in Milton Keynes. Our 2023 report reflects over **350** voices from parents and carers about their lived experience with a child or young person with SEND who live in Milton Keynes.

### The purpose of our Annual Survey?




What gender does your child/young person identify as?






What is the ethnic background of your child/young person?





What type of needs does your child / young person have? \*tick as many that apply







Do you consider your child or young person to have special educational needs and/ or disabilities (SEND)? If you answer 'no' to this question, the survey will close.







Is your child currently in education? (This includes pre-school, school, college or training)






### Which of the following applies to your child/young person?






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

How likely is it that you would recommend the service to others?






Does your child / young person get the right help and support to access leisure and community activities?




Does your child / young person have access to short break services?






Does your young person get the right support to prepare them for adulthood?
